- 1. March and April VMC and YE
 - a. Do YE after the March event. Keep an eye on the weather a week before if the weather looks good plan the event.
 - b. Airport manager from Cambridge is coming over to watch how we run the event.
- 2. March Program
 - a. Paul is going to develop a program
- 3. March 11 STEAM at the Museum
 - a. Sid and Bernie are going to put out the hot air balloon and the wind tunnel
- 4. Cambridge YE event
 - a. April 29th, 0900.
 - b. John and Darryl met with the airport manager on March 7th.
 - c. Airport manager wants to get county support, discounted fuel and catering.
 - d. Looking at full size rally; 50 kids if there are 10 pilots.
 - e. Operating out of the Terminal. Access to the conference room for the briefing.
 - f. County official, state representatives, mayor, and others will be in attendance.
- 5. RC Airplane Youth program
