Please bring some fix'ns if you can. We'll need salad, sides, chips, and desserts






# UPCOMINGEVENTS IMCYMC ELTE

If you are an early bird, we could use help with setup on Saturday morning. We'll start at about 6:30 in the morning.


If you are inclined to get up a little later, we need help operating the youth stations beginning at 7:30.
