Business from the Floor, Changes to Agenda

• James Johnson brought up that the airport has no pro-active fire defense plan. He suggests that the Chapter encourage and/or help the county to acquire an old pickup truck and equip it with a 250 gallon water tank and pump. Some discussion ensued.

Approval of Minutes:

- Motion: That the Minutes for the BOD meeting of July 10th, 2024 be adopted with the updated information that Merchandise sales at the Young Eagles event was \$160, with \$40 never received from Venmo, leaving \$120 actually received. Motion made by Rob, seconded by Tim, passed unanimously.

New Business:

Before The Movie:

Judi talked to Stephen Fuller, Senior Account Executive at "Before The Movie". We can highlight our Chapter in front of our local captive audience at the Placerville Theatre on all 8 screens before every movie, to show the community what we have to offer. Estimate is 800 ad plays per month. We can have a 15- or 30-second advertising slot at the Placerville Theatre, on all 8 screens, for 6 months or 12 months. Their creative team will help us to come up with the message which can include photos, video, music, our logo, our mission, interviews with aviation celebrities etc.

Costs are as follows:

\$399 one-time insertion fee.

Monthly costs:

30 seconds: 6 months: \$691/month, 12 months: \$553/month 15 seconds: 6 months: \$378/month, 12 months: \$299/month

The Board felt that the expense is too high for the Chapter, at this time. However, if we can share the advertising and costs with the county, to promote the airport along with the Chapter, we may be able to take advantage of this service. We will mention this opportunity to Jason Brand to see if he can get the county or the sheriff's department interested. Judi believes we may be able to negotiate the rates.

- O There was some discussion on whether we should continue providing funds for the Sunny Atkins Scholarship, as opposed to just putting the funds in general operating funds and transferring money for the Ray Scholarship matching funds as needed. It was pointed out that the Atkins Scholarship covers items not available under the terms of the Ray Scholarship; i.e., broader age group (14-22) and broader interests (any aviation related pursuits vs. just pilot's licenses). No action to change our current setup.
- \$100 cash received from Sunny for Gear Sales at the Young Eagles event. Report from Sunny and Lissie was that an additional \$60 from gear sales was paid to the chapter via Venmo, however only \$20 was received, and we are short by \$40.
- o 8/3/2024 Pancake Breakfast report:
 - 12 volunteers, 4 pilots, 90 paying adults, and 4 paying children
 - \$1,166 total: \$905 Pancake breakfast, \$106 donations, \$155 Gear sales
- Al Herron Coat Raffle. We re-applied for 2024 and 2025 Raffle Registration through 12/31/2025 on 8/5/2024. We are awaiting approval from the State.
- o Form RRF-1, Charitable Trust Registration shows current (no longer delinquent).

Secretary (Rob Bulaga):

o Holiday Party pricing was brought up. The question being, "Is this a fund raising event or an 'end of year' celebration. The Board's consensus is that this should be a 'free', pot-luck event, with the Chapter covering the minor expenses incurred.

 goal of this Club is to work together as a collective to raise funds for EAA Chapter 512 to
