 - Grant #2: Team Grant: 5 New York Life agents need to work on a project for at least 40 hours at \$17.50/hour (\$700) minimum to EAA 512.
 - Grant #3: Community Impact Grant: Competitive. Minimally \$5,000. Tim and Judi met with NYL today.
