

He even fired up the engine on one of the planes, so the audience could see how fast the propeller was spinning. It was impressive to learn that these RC racing planes complete a three-legged race course in roughly 8 seconds. These race planes are flying at approximately 115 mph, so it takes good hand-eye coordination to keep them on the race course. Everyone had a lot of questions for Duane after his formal presentation and we came away with a new-found
