## Another Young Eagle Takes To The Skies

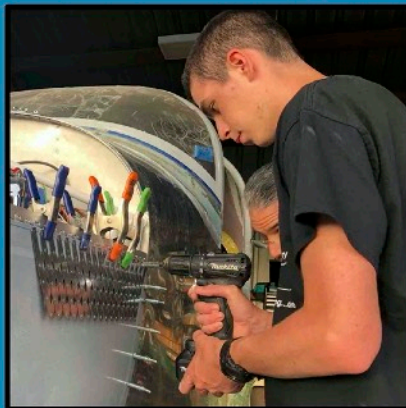
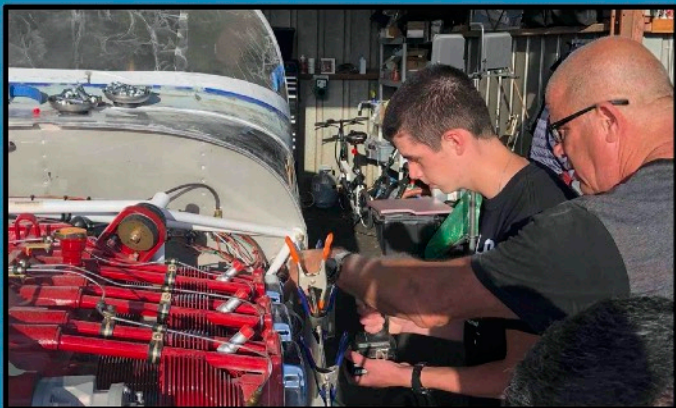
