The date is March 12<sup>th</sup> and this year it will be held at AOPA's National Aviation Community Center (NACC). The address is 296 Bucheimer Road, Frederick (the large hangar just south of our EAA hangar). Doors will open at 6:00 p.m., dinner starts at 6:30. The cost is \$50 per person. Meal options include Tuscan Pappardelle (pasta), Chicken Piccata or Cedar-Plank Salmon. There will also be Hors d'oeuvres, rice pilaf and vegetables, bread knots and dessert. Coffee and tea will be provided. Bring your own alcohol. There will be glassware and china for our use, and an attendant to clear empty dishes.

Our presenter will be Dr. Chris Lang, an emergency care physician at George Washington University Hospital. Dr. Lang is a former flight surgeon, and will be presenting on OTC medications and psychoactive substances.


