Sonex high wing mockup was interesting as well.

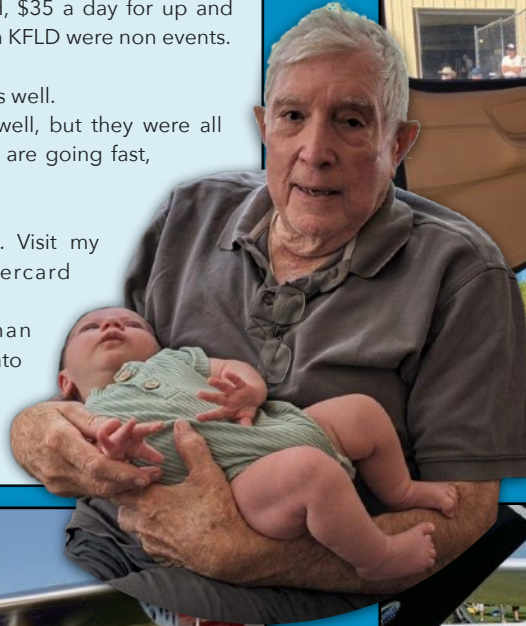
The Wittman Tailwind was on my list as well, but they were all lacking any creature comforts, but when you are going fast, who cares right?

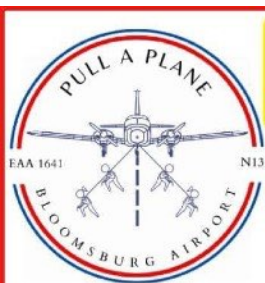
