




EAA Oshkosh - AirVenture 2023

johnt.baker Back to 1989 when John Beers was flying his highly modified Bakeng Deuce. He was a longtime member of EAA Chapter 524 in Frederick, Maryland. John, who passed away years ago, was a classic EAA homebuilder, long before the era of "fast build" kits. Scratch built in his garage in Silver Spring, Maryland, John incorporated numerous changes to the original design. He changed the shape of the tail surfaces and turtle deck to suit his tastes. He built a two place fiberglass engine cowling of his own design. Most significant was the landing gear modification. In place of the standard spring steel gear, John designed and built an outrigger gear that incorporated Aeronca oleo struts. John called the plane "Mina's Goose," in honor of Mina Paille, the legendary owner of Davis Airport (W50) in Laytonsville Maryland. On my 40th birthday, I was hanging out at the airport, completing an oil change on the Stinson. Sukey contrived for me to go flying in the "Goose" with my friend Jack Roberts. We ended up at College Park Airport (CGS) where Jack suggested we get a cool drink at the 94th Aero Squadron Restaurant on the field. Once inside, I was surprised by about 40 friends and family members. What a day. #airplanesarecool #eaa #bakengdeuce #eaa524
