Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Bob Miller

- Bob said the airport staff asked if we could do a pancake breakfast for the next airport open house. There's not a lot of money to be made, but it's a good draw and a good outreach tool.
- Bob reported that they have a few parts to put on the Rans and hoping it'll be done by the end of the month.
- Bob asked if we'd like to have a banquet this year (possibly during April). Ernie said that in the past, the Chapter helped to subsidize the banquet, and lost money on the event and the Chapter currently doesn't have a large surplus of funds.
- Linda reported that Pam Dickinson has volunteered to do the coordination for the banquet and catering. She's passing information to Pam to help guide the decisionmaking process. We will get an idea of costs before moving forward.
- ❖ Ernie and Dean have been working together on scholarships. Elijah has exhausted his funds and the Chapter doesn't have the income to continue paying for his training. Max has run past his pre-solo money. The Chapter has continued to support him and are running low on funds (more money will be put in his account once he solos), but EAA national has also inquired about when he will solo. In both cases, the families will have to pay for the continuation of their flight training. EAA is slower than we'd like in getting the money to us and we've had to continually front the money which has caused some issue. When Max solos, he will be eligible for more money, but the money won't arrive for 3-4 weeks (EAA requires proof, records, signature from CFI, etc. before sending the money).
- ❖ Larry said that Katie is all ready to go and can issue WINGS credit. She finished the EAA VMC Club coordinator program and has been briefed on all of the hangar's systems. Larry said there's a piece of tech inside the cart with instructions on how to hook the laptop and projector to the PA system in the hangar so computer audio can be audible. All set for the IMC Club meeting on Tuesday, Feb. 20. Katie will be in attendance to get familiar with how everything runs ahead of the VMC Club meeting on Feb. 21.
- Erick will order name tags this week and won't be in attendance at the next Chapter meeting in March (twins will be here).


