## MARTINSBURG LOCATION

Earn a Marshall University Professional Pilot, B.S. degree from Martinsburg, W.V.

Marshall University's Bill Noe Flight School (BNFS) is on a mission to help meet the nation's projected need for commercial pilots over the next 20 years through their Professional Pilot, B.S., degree program. The program's ground and flight courses lead to a series of FAA certifications and prepare graduates to become commercial pilots of single and multi-engine aircraft.

Starting in the fall of 2024, Marshall University's Bill Noe Flight School will offer the Professional Pilot B.S. program in Martinsburg, West Virginia through a hybrid program allowing students to take Marshall University courses online

and complete flight training through Marshall's BNFS at Eastern West Virginia Regional Airport (MRB). Ultimately allowing students to earn a Marshall University degree and FAA certification upon completion of the program.

In addition to the bachelor's degree program, Marshall University Aviation also offers direct pilot training for those who are not interested in earning a degree.

Meeting called to order at 7:02 pm by Bob Miller

- Bob said when Lynda was doing the Festival of Flight they needed a signed copy of the Chapter bylaws. Ernie has a box of documents that may contain the document; we will look for it. We learned a lot from the picnic and Festival of Flight regarding events and the amount of money spent and will be better prepared for the next events. We got a couple new members from the Festival of Flight and may have a few more to come.
- The RC group at the Festival of Flight mentioned something about doing RC projects alongside us to get younger people involved in aviation. We'll find out more information and revisit this.
- Lynda proposed having some hors d'oeuvres at the December meeting instead of a snack in a slightly more formal setting. Suggested starting the meeting earlier so there was more time to socialize and enjoy the food. Lynda or Bob will share more about it at the November meeting.
- Kevin shared that hats and shirts are still available. Hats are \$20. Picnic at Keymar went well; people stayed for a long time. Is there interest in trying to do two a year (spring and fall)? The Chapter banquet is normally in the spring, so we will continue to discuss timing. He would also like to do some fly-outs again and will pick a few places and put it on the calendar and will go regardless of how many signups there are.
- Mark P. shared that Mia Anderson will present in November about her ICAS Glider championship. December will be Patrick talking about formation fundamentals.
- Larry said IMC Club is proceeding as normal and had some great discussions recently. Last month the Sky High Flying Club did a movie night and had a great turnout.
- Ernie said that he's been having some frustrations regarding William's scholarship. We advanced him \$2,000 towards his training and it only got him 6 hours of flying time at Bravo. EAA sent the payment that should get him to solo, but the bottom line is if Ernie gives them \$5,000 instead of \$4,400, he will be credited \$250 (as a discount). Ernie put the \$4,400 plus \$600 from the Chapter funds into the account because he won't get his certificate at the slow rate EAA is providing the funds and at the rate Bravo has been going through the funds.
- Basel Hammond will be in Frederick Dec 11-24 from the UK and wants to visit the chapter. He was awarded 2 UK scholarships and will be applying for EAA scholarships this year. Also has aviation art he may bring along to sell. Offered to give a talk on aviation art. Builds will still be going on, so he could stop by on 14th and 21st to see some builds (Cessna 150 and Veterans Airplane).

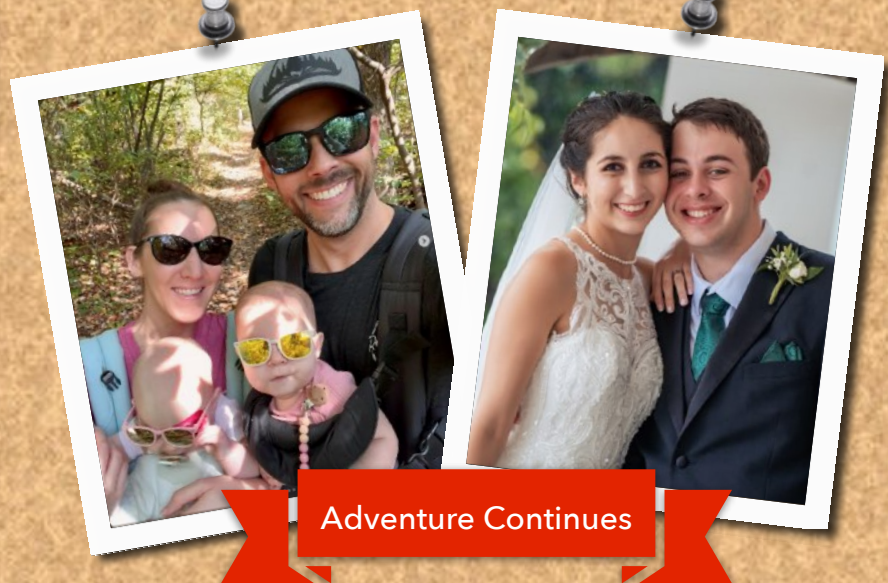
