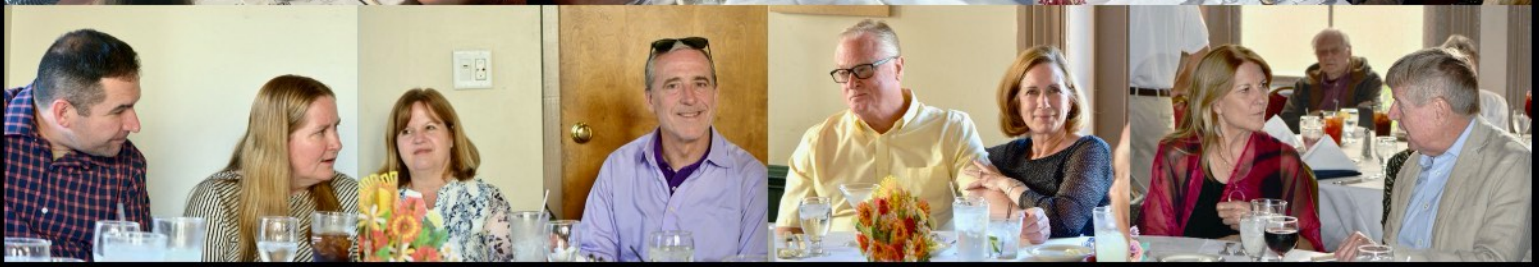

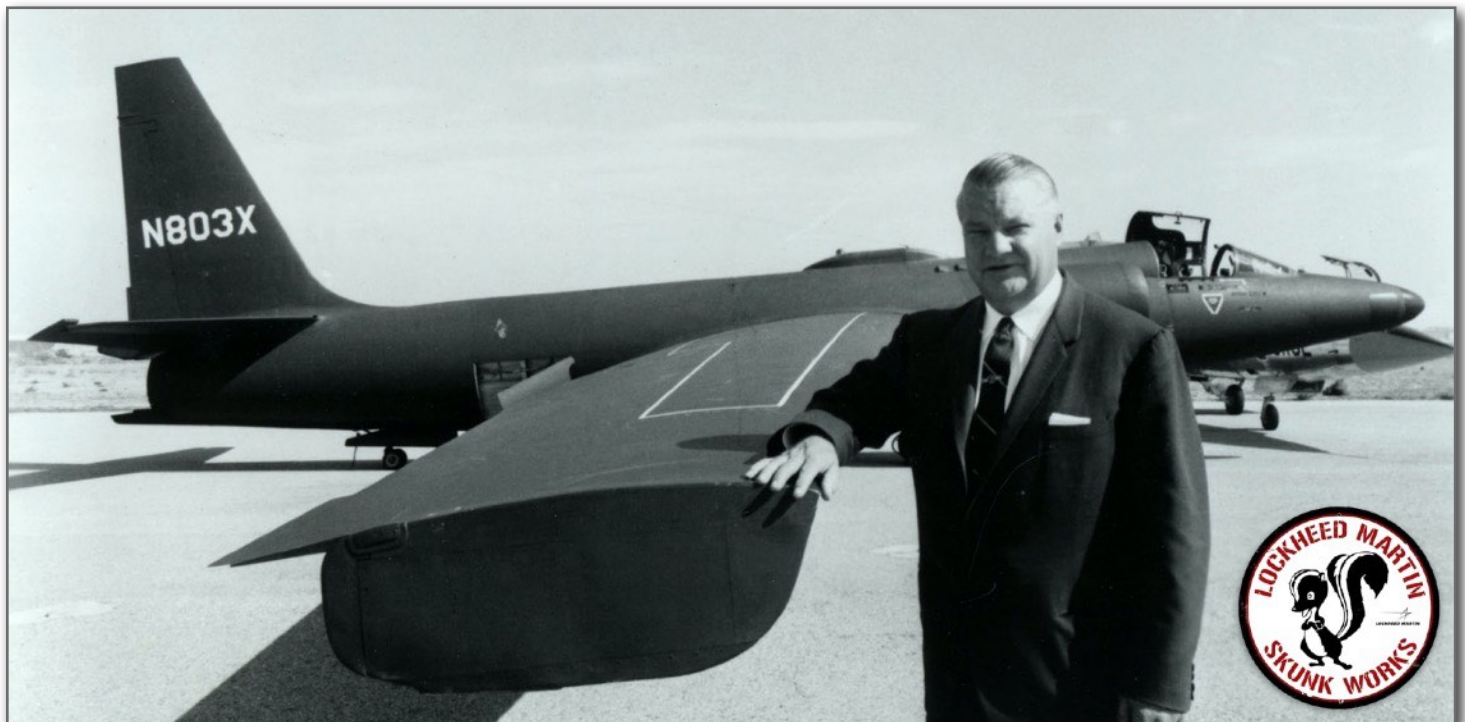

Meeting called to order at 7:04 pm by Bob Miller

- * Kevin shared that the Rans sold this past week for \$18,000. Jon Shimer bought it. Condition inspection is fully legal and signed off.
- * Kevin and Wendy were thinking about picnics, fly-outs, etc. and decided that Keymar (MD42) would be a great place to have a fly-in picnic. 1,900’ grass strip. Maybe September. Steve Gross has a commercial smoker he could bring and smoke some pork. September 14 was proposed as the date for the event and September 21 is the rain date. Need to clear the dates with Peter and Chelsea to make sure they’re okay with the dates. Mark P. will check with them.

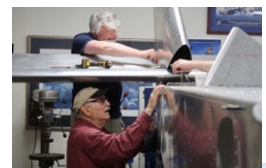
