


January Program

December Board Meeting Minutes

EAA Chapter 524 Board Meeting
11 Dec 2014

Conference call brought to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mark Gosselin.

Present were: Mark Gosselin, Mark Pankratz, Doug Kelly, Jack Fromm, Ernie O’Roark, and Erick Webb.

Mark G. spoke about hangar rent. Originally the Chapter signed a 5-year lease with the understanding that \$30k had been invested in renovating the hangar (used to offset rent) – conversations with airport management have alluded to the rent doubling (currently \$244/month) after the hangar reassessments take place (approximately July 2015).

Mark P. suggested speaking with AOPA about using their new facility for meetings as a possibility.

Mark G. suggested the idea of a get-together and have a movie night in the Chapter hangar at a time other than for a Chapter meeting. He suggested an aviation-related movie night open to members and their families with the possibility of having a pot luck dinner along with the movie/video.

Mark G. reported that he has a Young Eagles flight scheduled for Saturday, 13 Dec 2014, 0930 at Chapter hangar.

Mark P. spoke briefly about possible upcoming Chapter program presenters. Mark P will present a program, a Steve Copley will present, and Dan Morris will present.

Mark G. added that the Yak pilot at FDK would be willing to do a program.

Mark P. suggested Brewer’s Alley as a possible location for the Chapter banquet. He has done some research into the idea by speaking with Jackie Reynolds at Brewer’s Alley. The minimum expenditure for Friday or Saturday is \$1,500. It would include sit-down service with hors d’oeuvres along with meal and dessert.

Mark G. suggested astronaut Tom Jones as the speaker for banquet program.

Ernie reported that \$1,348 had been spent on 2014 banquet, but only \$966 was taken in for it.

Those present on the conference call made a unanimous decision to have the Chapter banquet at Brewer’s Alley on Saturday March 14, 2015. Cocktails to be started at 6/30 and dinner beginning at 7.

Ernie mentioned the Chapter’s need for a 2nd air compressor for workshops, as well as dedicated 20A circuit for secondary compressor. We will need a licensed electrician to do the work. Those present on the conference call unanimously approved the purchase of a compressor and to move forward with having the electrical work done.

Mark G. mentioned the Sonera donor and said that if the donor can’t get help to restore/sell the plane, he may donate it to an EAA chapter with a 501(c)(3).

Meeting adjourned at 8:17p.m.

Licensed Electrician Needed

As you probably noticed in the Board meeting minutes, we are in need of an electrician to do some wiring in the hangar. We have discovered in past RV sheet metal workshops that we need a second air compressor to provide enough capacity when there is full enrollment for the class. In the past, we have relied on one of our members to loan us one. But then we ran into another problem. Both compressors have to share the same electrical circuit and during peak demand, they would keep tripping the circuit breaker. So the Board voted to purchase a compressor to eliminate having to borrow one



and to pursue wiring a dedicated circuit for the second compressor.

That's where we need your help. We need to get this circuit in place before the RV workshop scheduled for January 17-18. If anyone knows of a licensed electrician that would be willing to do the work for us before January 16, please let Mark Gosselin know.

You may have also noticed from the Board minutes that plans are well underway for the Chapter banquet. The date has been set for March 14 and this year we will be having it at Brewer's Alley in Frederick. 


