Meeting called to order at 7:07PM by President Jim Suggs. Andrea Muller-Hoff read the minutes of the previous meeting. Upon motion of David Javarey, second by Andrea Muller-Hoff, and vote, the minutes were approved as read.

John Flanagan presented the Treasurer's Report:

Sharon Kaiser turned in \$950.00 in 2020 membership dues. Upon motion of Lou Kossler, second by Andrea Muller-Hoff, and vote, the Treasurer's Report was accepted as presented.

Guests Aaron Clark and Daniel Good were introduced.

Cessna 140 - Status: David Javarey reported that the oil was changed.

J-3 Cub - Status: David Javarey reported that metal was found in the oil screen. The plane is grounded pending further investigation.

Hovercraft update: John Flanagan said the lift duct prop has been glassed, and the lift duct engine was hung, temporarily.

New members, hangar access requests: Sharon Kaiser has not received any new applications this month. The problem with the radio signal has apparently been resolved, and newly renewed badges are opening the door to the hangar.

2020 Events: Jim Suggs reported that AOPA is hosting more fly-in's this year. An event will be held in Rochester on **September 11th & 12th**. Dave Baker asked if ultralights will be able to fly into the Class C airspace for the event. Lou Kossler commented that he believes that airspace authorization, via A.D.A.P.T., will be available; he will look into it.

Miscellaneous Items:

Wes sign for hangar: A new idea was floated, to put the sign on posts in front of the hangar, instead of mounting it directly on the metal siding.

Chapter website: Andrea Muller-Hoff reported that she has signed up for the webinar for the new website platform being rolled out by National. She stated that the chapter owns the domain name: EAA533.org. It will be a redirect from the national address.
