Presidents Report for December 2024

Welcome EAA Chapter Members, Family and Friends.

I look forward to seeing everyone at our annual Christmas Party. This year it will be held at Dillon' BBQ as usual. There will be great food and beverages. We will have drawings for various gifts and will sell tickets which will give you chances to win. The proceeds will be used for chapter activities as well as our hangar project. It is a time to relax and have fun while enjoying each other' company. It is located on 59th Avenue in Glendale in the private meeting room. Come on out and have a great time.

Our hangar is coming along nicely. We have been meeting every Saturday for the past several weeks. During this time we have framed up the bathrooms and hung the drywall. I have taped and mudded up the walls with 2 coats of joint compound with lots of sanding in-between. The walls have been painted with primer and a back-splash has been put up in each of the two bathrooms. The plumber is expected to come this week to do the finish plumbing. The electrician is expected to complete the finish electrical in each of the rooms. For us is to hang the doors and apply a final coat of paint. The building itself is almost done with the trim to be placed along the roof on the front side of the building. 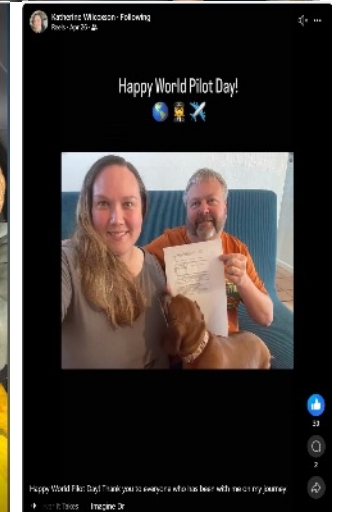
