Interesting note from Jack Norris:

The below was not performed by me, just observed. i thought it might be of interest for the newsletter.

Repair saga:

Sonex with a Jabiru 3300....running rough at 2300rpm and really rough at 2600+. Why?

The engine had been sitting for a number of years and the experimental aircraft purchased by the pilot now experiencing the problem. Expected good deal....wasn't?

Troubleshooting began with putting on a more suitable propeller. RPM and power improvements, but roughness/missing still there. Ignition checked, OK, plugs changed.

Fuel delivery became the source of the next series of troubleshooting steps. Fuel flow within specs, so focus shifted to carb and fuel pump. No electric back-up

fuel pump, so one installed. Mechanical fuel pump met specs. Fuel delivery to carb was eliminated as source of malfunction. Carb taken apart which revealed no apparent malfunction. Jets changed to provide richer mixture at higher RPM. No improvement. Mounted a new carburetor, problem eliminated. Old carb was rebuilt including a new diaphragm. The diaphragm appeared in excellent condition...but it was not. The amount of time the engine sat unused caused the diaphragm to atrophy and operate in a rigid fashion instead of the flexible movement designed by Bing. Problem solved.

# Chandler Municipal Airport

**Chandler Municipal Airport** (ICAO: **KCHD**, FAA LID: **CHD**) is in Maricopa County, Arizona 3 miles (2.6 nmi; 4.8 km) southeast of Chandler, which owns it.<sup>[1]</sup> The National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems for 2011–2015 categorized it as a general aviation reliever airport.<sup>[2]</sup>

Chandler Municipal is one of the nation's 50 busiest general aviation airports. It adds to Arizona's economy by bringing in more than \$53 million annually. No airlines operate out of Chandler and none plan to in the near future.<sup>[3]</sup>

Most U.S. airports use the same three-letter location identifier for the FAA and IATA, but Chandler Municipal is CHD to the FAA<sup>[4]</sup> and has no IATA code (IATA had assigned **CHD** to Phoenix-Mesa Gateway Airport in Mesa, Arizona<sup>[4]</sup> - since redesignated by the IATA as **AZA**).

## Facilities

The airport covers 550 acres (220 ha) at an elevation of 1,243 ft (379 m). It has two asphalt runways:

- 4L/22R measuring 4,401 ft × 75 ft (1,341 m × 23 m)
- 4R/22L measuring 4,870 ft × 75 ft (1,484 m × 23 m)

It has one concrete helipad,

- H1 measuring 100 ft × 100 ft (30 m × 30 m)<sup>[1]</sup>

The airport has built and improved a heliport facility, airport signage, and aircraft parking space by 10 acres with 90 tie-down spaces. These improvements were made over the last 6 years and cost about \$7 million. The privately owned parking spaces are at 100% capacity. Affiliated Property Management is the name of the company/HOA that controls

In the year ending April 25, 2011 the airport had 161,750 aircraft operations, average 443 per day: 98% general aviation, 2% air taxi, and <1% military. 333 aircraft were then based at the airport: 86% single-engine, 9% multi-engine, 3% helicopter, 1% jet, and 1% ultralight.<sup>[4]</sup>
