PRESIDENTS REPORT FOR AUGUST 2024

Welcome EAA Chapter 538 Members, Family and Friends,

Airventure is now over. The Experimental Aircraft Association's premier event has come to a close. This year set a record attendance of 686,000 people exceeding last year's record of 677,000 people. Over 10,000 planes arrived at the Wittman Regional Airport with 16,780 aircraft operations from July 18-28. During this time an average of 113 takeoffs/landings per hour. 2,846 show planes including 1200 vintage aircraft, 975 homebuilt aircraft, 337 warbirds, 154 ultralights and light planes, 82 aerobatic aircraft, 65 seaplanes and amphibians, 23 rotorcraft and 10 balloons. Over 15,000 sites in aircraft and drive-in camping accounted for more than 40,000 visitors. Nearly 6,000 volunteers donated more than 250,000 hrs to the event.

Another record of 861 commercial vendors were showcased during the event along with more than 1,600 forums, workshops and presentation sessions. 2,581 attendees registered at the International Visitors Tent with another record setting 98 countries from outside the United States.

The EAA Aviation Foundation's annual event attracted more than 1000 people and raised, (you guessed it) a record \$2.8 million that will be used to focus on its mission of growing participation in aviation. 836 media representatives were on site from six continents. It is estimated that the economic impact for the Oshkosh area is \$170 million. In short, you can spend the whole week there and not see it all. Now to get ready for Airventure 2025.

Ok, now...

So who went this year? Carlos Hernandez flew his recently completed RV7. I am anxious to hear his story. Anyone else? Whether you traveled commercial, flew your own plane, hitchhiked, tell us your story. We would love to hear it.

Our hangar is progressing nicely. Recently we had the sprinkler system installed and have initiated the electrical work. The electrical work will take some time as we are waiting on an electrical cabinet that is on backorder. We have begun to frame up the bathrooms and storage room. This is necessary to do so that portion of electrical and plumbing can be installed in the rough framing stage. I would like to invite anyone out to help. We are currently working Saturday mornings. I would also like to place a call for building materials. We will need about 8 sheets of 3/4 subfloor plywood. Also about 40 sheets of 4x8x1/2 inch drywall. Any amount of the above is helpful. Monetary donations are greatly appreciated to complete the hangar project. Remember our chapter is a 501c3 non-profit organization so there may be a potential tax benefit for any donations.





Chinle Municipal Airport (<u>FAA LID</u>: **E91**), also referred to as **Chinle Airport**, is a public-use <u>airport</u> located 4 <u>miles</u> (3.5 <u>nmi</u>; 6.4 <u>km</u>) southwest of the <u>central business district</u> of <u>Chinle</u>, in <u>Apache County</u>, <u>Arizona</u>, <u>United States</u>. It is owned by the <u>Navajo Nation</u>.

As per <u>Federal Aviation Administration</u> records, the airport had 131 passenger boardings (enplanements) in <u>calendar year</u> 2005 and 2,059 enplanements (all unscheduled) in 2006. According to the FAA's National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems for 2007–2011, Chinle is a <u>general aviation</u> airport (the <u>commercial service</u> category requires at least 2,500 passenger boardings per year).

This is one of six airports owned by the <u>Navajo Nation</u>; the other five being <u>Kayenta Airport</u> (0V7), <u>Tuba City Airport</u> (T03) and <u>Window Rock Airport</u> (RQE) in Arizona, plus <u>Crown point Airport</u> (0E8) and <u>Shiprock Airport</u> (5V5) in New Mexico.


