Our chapter has taken responsibility for the old Warbird building next door. It will need a new porch, but will provide our chapter with an additional facility for many additional activities.

Colleen Wright reported on an initiative from EAA, called "Flying Start". This will be similar to the Young Eagles program, but focused on adults. EAA provides resources to the local chapters that are interested in promoting flying in the community. The chapter would need 3 or 4 volunteers to head this up.
