In Addition to the Activities & Programs in 2024, We also had...

An excellent year from a financial standpoint in which the club took in \$36,440.24 from sponsorships, fundraisers, dues and individual donations. This is remarkable for a club our size and it really shows the health of the chapter. While it's great to receive this amount of money in a single year, we are a non-profit and we use the money received to help grow participation in aviation. The money we've spent has gone towards doing just that. Things like the True Course Sim, YE Build & Fly project, meals & drinks, advertising are just some of the ways we look to increase awareness in the community and introduce others to our wonderful aviation community.

We had new people stepping up in big ways to fill roles that are sometimes behind the scenes and don't get the recognition they deserve. We've also had those that have been here since before the resurgence of the chapter a short while ago. This year, we had a couple of new board members, a membership coordinator, tool crib manager, and an EAA technical counselor to name a few!

We also flew 120 Young Eagles during four rallies, 10 Eagles at two flying start programs, reached silver level status in the chapter, hosted a CAP hangar tour, flew radio control airplanes, had a float in the 4th of July parade, replaced all three breakfast griddles, awarded a Ray Aviation Scholarship, awarded three scholarships on the sim and were invited once again to participate in the Subaru Share the Love Event!

The True Course Simulations ITD is 100% ready to go!

We had to work out a few things and make sure everything was in order before we could offer the sim for full use.

TJ Hess has been our "Test Pilot" during the early testing of the sim and has been instrumental in working with True Course to identify potential issues and help resolve them. Early on, something in the computer failed and it had to be replaced. That was followed by an intermittent problem with the headset losing connection. True Course stepped up and replaced the computer at no cost to the chapter and they were also able to diagnose the headset issue which turned out to be our own doing when the unit was mounted on a movable base. AJ, Kyle and the rest of the team at True Course were simply outstanding in their commitment to get the unit in tip top condition and keep it that way.
