


June Board Meeting Recap:

- Checking account balance is \$4,308.38 and cash box balance is \$332.20 (6/27/23)
- At the conclusion of the May board meeting, Mike Jackson resigned his position on the board given that he and his wife have plans to travel quite a bit this summer. Mike felt he would be doing the chap ter a disservice to stay on the board and then not attend meetings. We thank Mike for the things he helped the chapter accomplish during his time on the board. Mike's resignation left an empty seat on the board that needed to be filled. President Ed Hamilton appointed Nolan Brimhall to the vacant seat. We are excited to have Nolan on board!
- 501c3 application has finally been accepted by the IRS and we are now awaiting approval and issuance of the letter confirming status.
- Teenie-Two Aircraft is in our possession and being refurbished for use in the 4th of July Parade.
- Parades Already registered for the Show Low 4th of July Parade Will register for the Pioneer Days Parade in Snowflake later in July. Brent is handling the registration.
- Parade Budget At this point, all costs are being covered and donated by members working on the float and handouts/fliers. Costs will be tracked and compiled to establish a budget for next year.
- Volunteer Appreciation Banquet Rescheduled for it's own day on August 18th.
- Ground School Discussion Tabled until next meeting.
- Fly-Outs Charlie Ballard received feedback from the surveys that were sent out. Based on the feedback he received, he will plan fly-outs accordingly. Frequency will be every other month.
- Airventure Bracelets from the Flying Start event Jeff Hess and Kimberly Jackson have both accepted the bracelets that were given to the chapter for hosting the flying start event. Jeff, TJ and Kimberly are the only chapter members going to Oshkosh that we are aware of. Kimberly extended her generosity and purchased two additional bracelets for Don Lusk and Brian Rollins (two others that are going to Oshkosh)
- Facebook Got off to a really strong start. We need to feed the beast and make sure all chapter offer ings are posted and keep content coming.
- EAA Roster Management Tool is active. Ed and Shay have been updating the member info. Once they have everything updated, we will make the tool active to the board members.
- Scholarship Criteria put together by Brent Brent needs feedback on the form to finalize.
- Chapter Gathering & Newsletter Content Should this be reviewed and approved by the board monthly. We will continue as we have been doing with Don Lusk putting the content together for both the newsletter and gatherings.
- Emergency Media Plan Revone (chapter safety officer) has completed the plan and posted it in the hangar along with the In Case of Emergency (ICE) binder (also in the hangar). She will present on the subject in the July chapter gathering.
- Calendar Review Nominations Committee in August, WDR/Pancake Breakfast/YE Rally in September, Nominations review in September, Chapter Elections in October.
- Derby Down the Deuce Event has been discontinued by the City of Show Low. We can use car kit parts for some other chapter activity to be determined at a later date.
- Mogollon Chapter Pancake Breakfast We need to support and promote this event for our fellow chapter. We will advertise it in the newsletter and at the gathering.
- Craig Albright Had to cancel seminar on bicycles to bi-planes given circumstances beyond his control. He will review his calendar and let us know his next opportunity.
