Just a short while ago, our chapter didn't have many members or a lot of activity going on and at that time managing the membership roster was a fairly easy task and could be done by one person already wearing many hats. I'm happy to report that this is no longer the case because our chapter has grown substantially in the last two years! Recently, Diana Krugh took on the role of Membership Coordinator and she has been very busy trying to get everyone's information updated in Roster Management, a tool provided to chapters from headquarters.
