

What a difference a year makes! In 2022, our chapter scored 4 out of 11 on the scale that is used to establish chapter ranking. A score of 7 out of 11 = Bronze, 8 out of 11 = Silver and 9 out of 11 = Gold. At the conclusion of 2023, we scored 8 points and were recognized at the Silver Level.

Here is the criteria chapters are graded on and how we scored in 2023:

- 1. Attends a chapter leadership training session: 1
- 2. Growing or steady membership: 1
- 3. Offers IMC or VMC Club programs: 1
- 4. Participates in Young Eagle or Flying Start programs: 1
- 5. Has EAA-approved Flight Advisor or Technical Counselor: 0
- 6. Participates in EAA's Annual Chapter Member Survey: 1
- 7. Participates in Young Eagles Build and Fly, Young Eagles Workshops, Ray Aviation Scholarship program, or sends a youth to EAA's Air Academy: 1
- 8. Requests an EAA ChapterBlast email: 1
- 9. Hosts at least two public events each year: 1
- 10. Owns/leases a facility: 0
- 11. Extra credit activity, such as a chapter build project, youth build project, chapter scholarship, a chapter tool crib, IAC competition, etc: 0



When we attended the virtual leadership academy in 2023, I thought it was interesting to learn that less than 19% of all chapters are rated bronze or better. It should be noted that we didn't learn of this criteria and then set out to achieve a specific level of recognition. We instead, sought to offer programs that would benefit the chapter members, network aviation enthusiasts and share the freedom of flight with the local community. I believe this is the reason our chapter has been thriving like it has which resulted in the recognition from headquarters.

I've said it a few times over but it's worth repeating... EAA Chapter 586 would be nothing without it's members and their dedication and commitment to everything the chapter has to offer!






