EAA Chapter 586 is excited to follow and support Elena on her aviation journey!




As we begin to transition out of 2023 and look forward to 2024, we would like to hear from you.


During chapter activities and meetings from now until the end of December there will be comment cards available and a deposit box that you can write in things you would like to see the chapter do or offer in 2024.
