We'll reveal and discuss the answer to this question before watching and discussing the VMC Video of the month. This opportunity is open to everyone and we hope to see you at the meeting.

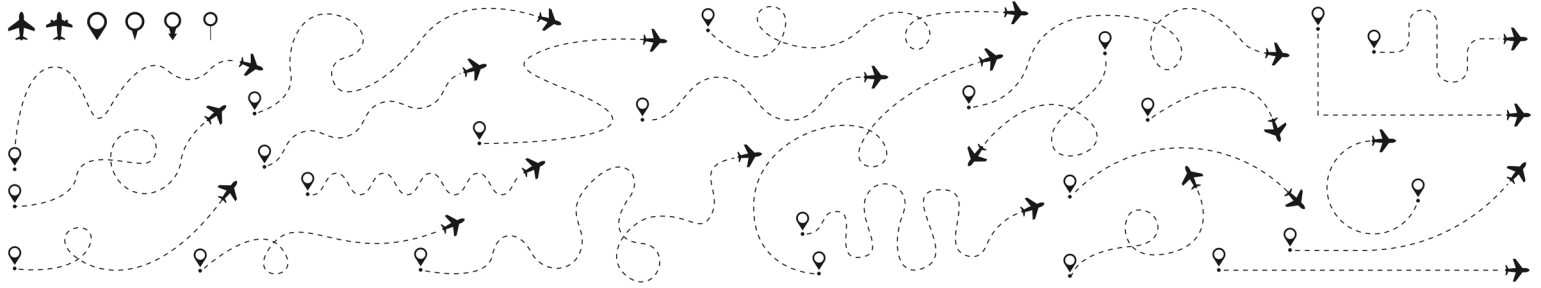

Registration for the rally will open on YEDay.org on October 9th, 2023. Please confirm your participation for the event through the website so we have an accurate list of volunteers for the rally.

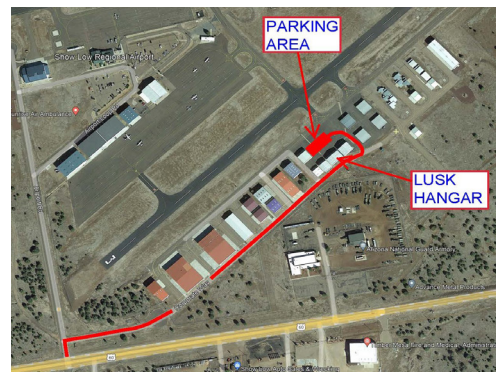
This will be our last Young Eagle Rally of the year. With the help of the Chapter 586 Volunteer Crew, we will close out the year on a high note!
