August Question: You are flying a high wing airplane at a low power setting right at the point of stalling. You abruptly add full power. Describe what happens.


August Answer: The abrupt increase in angular momentum of the rotating crankshaft and propeller will introduce an opposite rotational effect causing the airplane to stall the left wing and enter into a counterclockwise downward spin. Old P-51 pilots will tell you they were careful to properly make power changes when landing to avoid a similar behavior that could lead to an abrupt turn into the ground.
