Other News




Main Meeting

Northeast Side Taildraggers R/C Aviation Club Change of Location

The NeST RC club has a new field address: 12896 E. 166th St. in Noblesville, about 2.4 miles / 2.1 NM from Noblesville Airport. This is slightly farther from the airport than our previous location behind the fire station on Olio Road. A new FAA authorization allows our club to fly up to 1200' AGL for normal operations, sunrise to sunset. Even with the new authorization, they expect their operations will still usually be below 400' AGL. The links below will provide additional details on the new Authorization.
