Other News

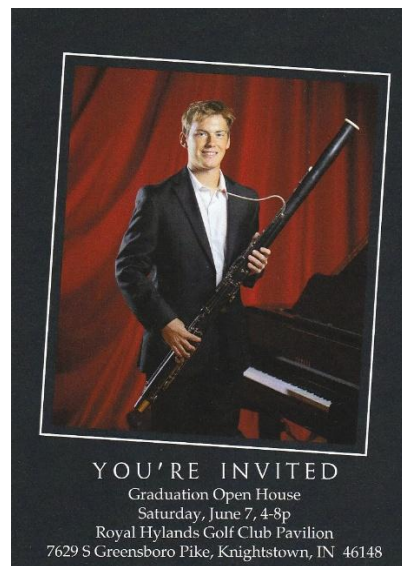
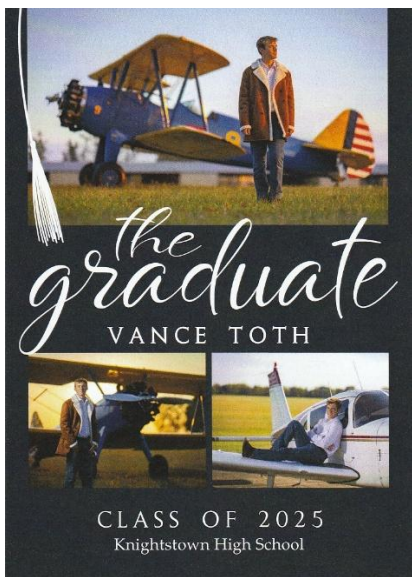

Northeast Side Taildraggers R/C Aviation Club Change of Location

The [NeST RC club](#) has a new field address: [12896 E. 166th St. in Noblesville](#), about 2.4 miles / 2.1 NM from Noblesville Airport. This is slightly farther from the airport than our previous location behind the fire station on Olio Road. A new FAA authorization allows our club to fly up to 1200' AGL for normal operations, sunrise to sunset.
