

Meeting Minutes - April 2025

Business meeting minutes

4/7/25

- Nick Boland called the meeting to order at 6:00PM
 The March minutes (attached to the Newsletter), were approved.
- Robert Goudreau presented the Chapter financial statements. \$15,470 cash at the end of March. In early April the chapter received \$2,000 reimbursement for flight training expenses. During March \$1,339 was spent on the L3 restoration project. 66 members have paid their 2025 chapter dues to date.
- Rick Hixson reported on Young Eagles. Our two main Chapter YE events are tentatively scheduled for June 22 and August 24, the Sundays following our pancake breakfast. The Young Eagle coordinators (Allan, Brittany, and Rick) need to firm up those dates/times as and discuss potential additional events. We need to get these events on the EAA national website.
