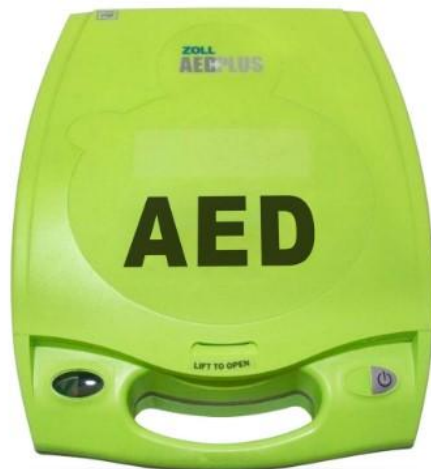
Pitch-In 6:30 PM

Thursday was the **Blue Angles** practice day. They did about an hour of doing some simple maneuvers to get the lay of the land, took about an hour break, and then did a full run through of the show for practice. Since it's not marketed as the show (Friday and Saturday), almost nobody was around. This is ground support that you don't often see because of the crowd. They have medical officer, videographer, and communications with tower and pilots. The guy with the light gun points it at the incoming aircraft(s) to help them find show center.

Meeting Minutes - March 2025

Business Meeting Minutes

- Nick Boland called the meeting to order at 6:00PM
- The **February minutes** were approved.
- The Chapter earned **\$250 in Young Eagle Credits** for 2024. We are required to submit appropriate 2025 expenses for reimbursement by January 21, 2026

- Robert Goudreau presented the **Chapter financial statements**. The chapter has just over \$16,000 in cash. Robert noted that we have approximately \$3,100 in obligations to our two current Ray Aviation Scholars (once they incur the training expenses). Nearly 60 members have paid their 2025 chapter dues. He noted that a number of members have not yet paid. A reminder will be included in our next newsletter.
- The Commemorative Air Force has slots for 25 Ray Aviation Scholars this year. The local wing will have 3 Ray Scholars. Interested parties should talk to Fred Fritz.
- There was no **Old Business** nor **New Business** to discuss.
- Nick reported on the history of the **Chapter 67 L3**. John Waymire graciously donated this project to Chapter 67 several years ago. The restoration project has been a great learning experience for students as well as chapter members. An EAA chapter cannot own a flying aircraft. Upon completion the L3 will likely be sold to a local flying club. This is still TBD.
- Much progress has been made on the L3. The frame has been bead blasted, primed and painted. The left wing is ready to be recovered. With experience from the left wing, progress on the right wing is faster. Brad Beaver is forming the boot cowling. The chapter is still working on sourcing an acceptable engine.
- We will be hosting two **Young Eagles events** the Sundays after our Pancake Breakfast, Precise timing of these events are still TBD. The Young Eagles Team is also considering additional events. More to come.
- Our two active **Ray Scholars**, Grace and Riley are working on their **written** tests. The chapter did not apply for any additional Ray Scholarships for 2025.
- **Purdue Aviation Day** is **Saturday April 5: 9 AM – 4PM** at Purdue. Admission is free.
