

Meeting Minutes - February 2025

Business Meeting Minutes

- Nick Boland called the meeting to order at 6:00PM
- The January meeting was snowed out.
- Several commented that the December pitch-in/party was a great event
- Robert Goudreau presented the Chapter financial statements. During
 January the Chapter collected \$1,122 in donations and membership dues
 and paid EAA National dues and insurance. Net Revenue for the month
 was \$481. The chapter has \$17,503 cash plus the L3 Aeronca. We have
 accrued \$2,221 in liabilities for Ray Aviation Scholarship activities
- There was no Old Business nor New Business to discuss.
- Considerable progress has been made on the Chapter L-3. Steel frame
 has been cleaned, primed and painted. The Horizontal stabilizer is well
 underway, The Chapter is looking at purchasing a C65 block.

- The Young Eagles team is considering moving the two Young Eagles
 events to the Sunday after our Pancake Breakfast, starting late morning.
 There was considerable discussion on this issue. Weather has been a
 factor for these two events. Later flights can encounter higher winds and
 bumpier rides. The Young Eagles Team is also considering additional
