

Business Meeting

- Reports
 - Brittany-Secretary/Young Eagles:
 - No meeting minutes from last meeting as Brittany was absent.
 - YE Rally was cancelled due to weather/lack of pilots due to weather conditions.

• Bob-Treasurer:

- \$18291 in the bank
- \$5816 ear marked for Ray
- Membership 83 members, 75 active and 8 students. Over projected budget!
- Pancake breakfast Finances
 - Meals served:
 - 503 adults
 - 235 kids
 - 39 comp
 - Total: 777
 - \$5374 total
 - Expenses \$1766 as of 7/1
