8. Appendix D Wiring Diagrams

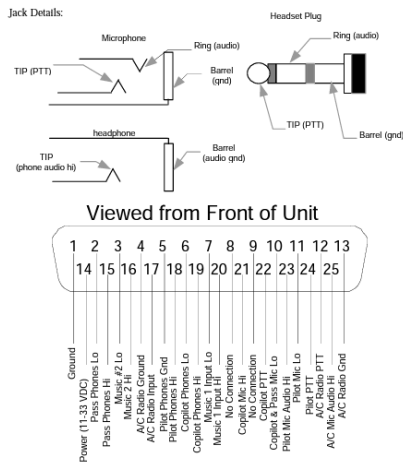
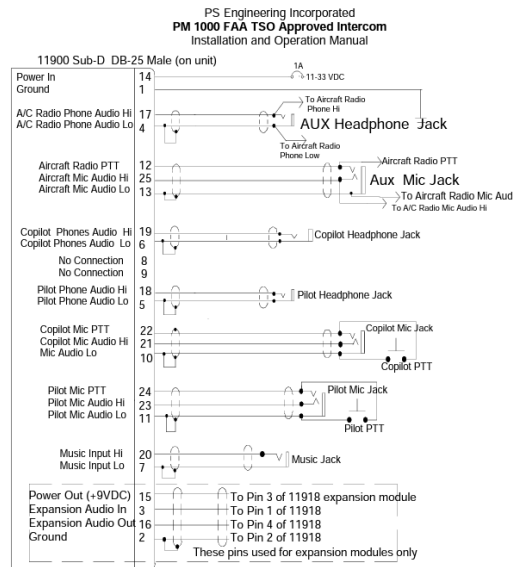


Figure 2 Connector Diagram (Unit has Male Pins)



- NOTES: All wire must conform to MIL-22759 or 27500. Minimum 24 gauge shielded wire.
- Use 2-, 3-, and 4-conductor with shield as indicated.
 - Use insulating washers on all jacks.
 - Connect shields at intercom end only.
 - AUX headphone and microphone jacks are required.
