### Meeting Notes:

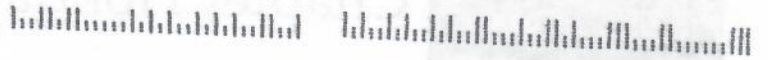

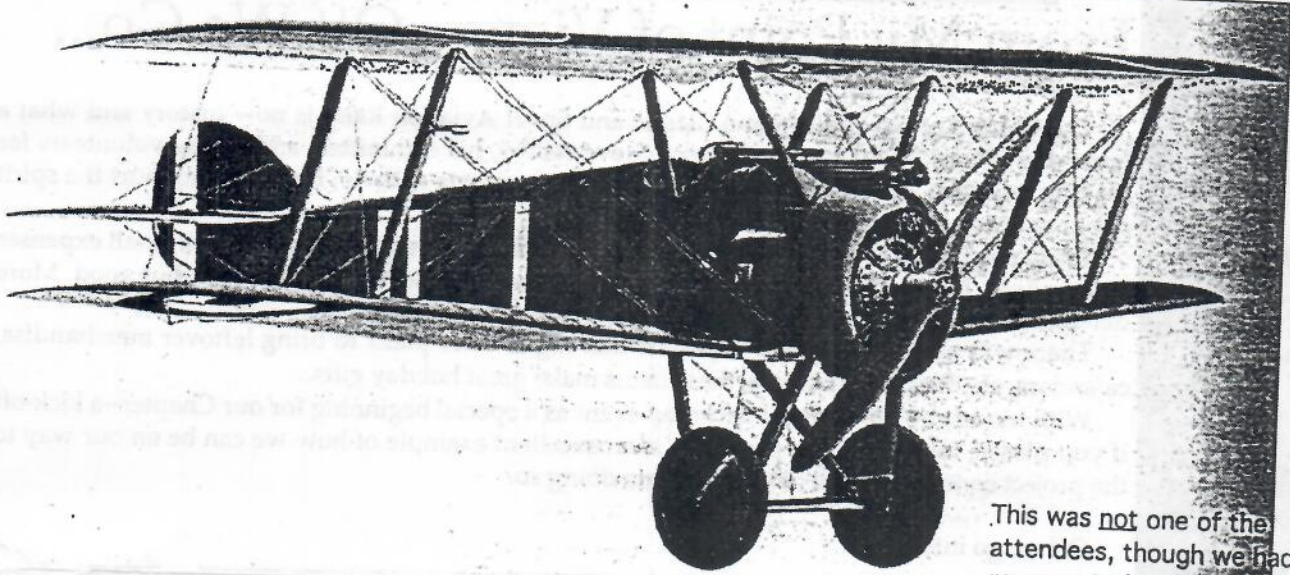


### Next Month:
