Don Hawk Memorial Scholarship

Instructions for submitting your application:

1. The candidate should reside within the Big horn Basin.
2. The candidate should be enrolled in an accredited *Professional Pilot, A&P Mechanic, Aviation Management* or related professional aviation program through an accredited college or university, or FAA approved F.B.O. program acceptable to the membership.
3. The intent of the scholarship is to assist the student in pursuing a career in aviation. Therefore, if the candidate is seeking advanced pilot training leading to commercial flying then the *Private Pilot Certificate* must have already been attained prior to submitting the application. If the student is pursuing one of the many other careers in aviation, they must have completed at least one semester of the school or work study program. Please submit the appropriate transcripts or instructor's evaluations.
4. If your application is approved, you will be awarded \$1,000.00. After successful completion of the first semester or your pilot certificate or rating, you may apply for a second award of \$1,500.00, for which you will be required to submit another application. A total award of \$2,500.00 is therefore possible toward your aviation training.
5. Applicants for the scholarship that are enrolled in the Northwest College program through Choice Aviation or other FAA approved college or university program should submit their application by the following dates:
 - By July 1 for the fall semester
 - By November 1 for the spring semester
6. An EAA 713 member will be assigned to assist you in the application process.
7. As part of the application process, the applicant will be interviewed by our Scholarship Committee and be invited to attend a Chapter meeting so that we can meet and get to know you. Meetings are held the second Tuesday of each month and start at 6:00 pm with dinner, at which you will be our guest. During the meeting following dinner, we ask that you introduce yourself and briefly tell of your future career plans in aviation.

8. As a successful applicant, you will automatically become a Chapter 713 member for the current membership year and will be required to attend two or more monthly meetings during the semester.

The Don Hawk Memorial Scholarship is a fee remission scholarship in the amount of \$1,000. After successful completion of the first semester, you may apply for a second award of \$1,500.00 for the second semester, for which you will be required to submit another application. A total award of \$2,500.00 is therefore possible toward your aviation training, valid only at the aviation related educational facility applied for below.

The scholarship is to be awarded after due consideration of the student's professional interest in a field of aviation, scholastic ability and achievements, character, and extra-curricular activity.
