This is the first newsletter for our new **EAA Bruce McCombs Chapter 72**. The new chapter is also now a 501(c)(3) with new bylaws. We have accepted into the new Chapter the donation of the Rans S19 from Ken Hendrickson. Ken will now be able to take a tax deduction for the donation of the Rans. 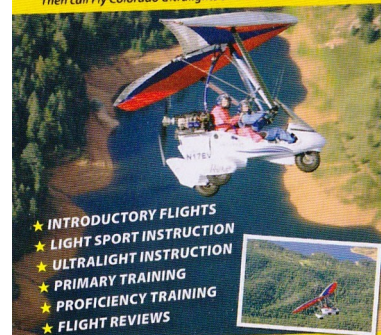
