VICE-PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

We have several things planned over the next couple of months, and by the time you read this, we'll probably be having our annual dinner at The Old Spaghetti Factory on 15 March 2025. I expect this to be just as good as the past events I've attended. The ticket price was \$35, and I'm glad we were able to keep this price the same as last year's dinner. I fear we'll be forced to update that price next year. So, if you missed our sign-up sheets, then mark your calendars for next year and don't miss it. It's always in March and the food is fantastic!

We'll be starting April off with a bang with our first Young Eagles (YE) event of the year. As many of you know we were forced to cancel March's YE's event due to technical issues with the new website and coordination with everyone. So, this will be our first YE event of the year and as always, it's our coffee & donuts day as well. But this year, we're throwing you a curve ball and hosting our first ever Fly Market event to buy and sell aviation related gear. You'll see an advertisement for that further down in this newsletter. The normal April chapter meeting will be on 19 April 2025, and we'll be focusing on the mental aspects of flying. Ken Johnson and our new YE's coordinator Raquel

Dominguez will both be presenting two different presentations regarding the mental aspects of flying. I've spoken to both, and I personally can't wait for you to see what they have to share. Lunch will be provided afterwards, and we'll be grilling burgers and brats! We'll need a couple of volunteers to help with the setup and tear down. Please arrive an hour before if you wish to help setup. If you choose to stay and help tear down, then when you leave it is up to you. The meeting will begin at 11AM immediately followed with lunch.

I believe that our normal May event (15 May 2025 / 9AM to 3PM) is going to be the biggest event for this chapter so far. We will be doing Eagle Flights as part of National's Learn to Fly program. This is also a fly-in event, but anyone flying in will be forced to park in the MLAA parking ramp area just northeast of the runway. This is because the Bravo ramp, in front of the MLAA hangar, will be closed for all traffic and we're only allowing access to exhibitors and visitors. There will be no vehicles of any type allowed within the Bravo ramp area during this event. Speaking of exhibitors, Flight for life will have a helicopter on display, Civil Air Patrol will be on hand with one of their aircraft. We're expecting to see at least 20 different aircraft parked on the ramp for static displays. Many of the flight schools, as well as one of the local A&P schools will be on hand. We have also arranged with Colorado Springs tower for someone to present and answer questions on the FAA Air Traffic Controller (ATC) duties and responsibilities. They will discuss what training is involved to pursue an ATC career. This is a learn to fly event, so expect to learn all about the many pathways to aviation success. We will be discussing glider, sport, private, and helicopter licensing processes as well as having all those static aircraft displays on hand. We will be doing presentations in the upstairs

briefing area non-stop from 9:30AM to 3PM. We'll post the presentation list in next month's newsletter. There is no charge for this event! Food and refreshments will be provided at cost, but you may bring your own food and refreshments if you choose. No alcohol will be allowed during this event for safety reasons. Emergency services, Falcon Fire Department, Falcon Police, and the State Police will all be bringing equipment and vehicles to display. I can't wait to see everyone at this event!


