Rick McKinney presented a chapter service award to Dave Bowman for his work with the Young Eagles program.

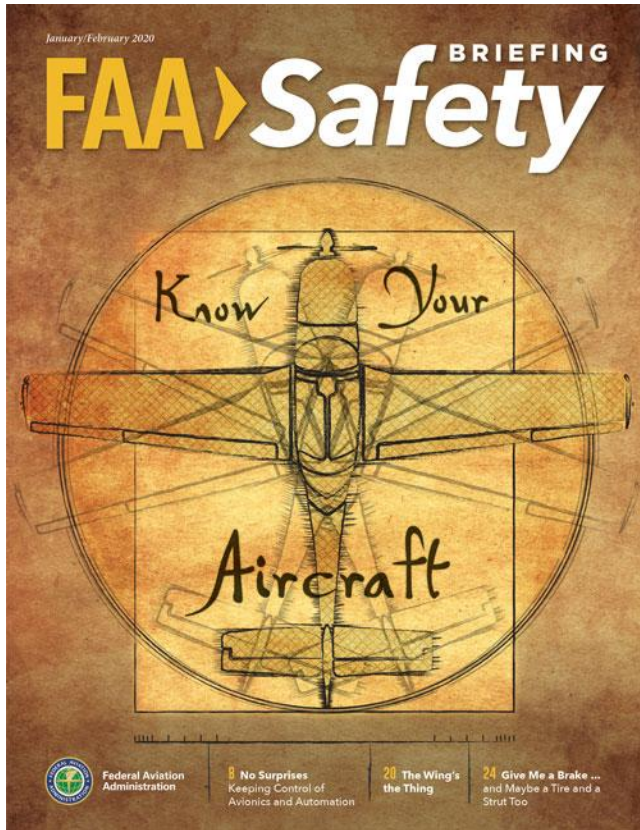
There will be a Chapter Leadership Boot Camp in Kansas City, MO on March 7, there are several of our members who will be attending. Let Larry know if you are interested.

Justin Tisdale is proud to announce that as of February 4th he has completed 26 hours in a Diamond 40 and was just signed off to take his written exam.

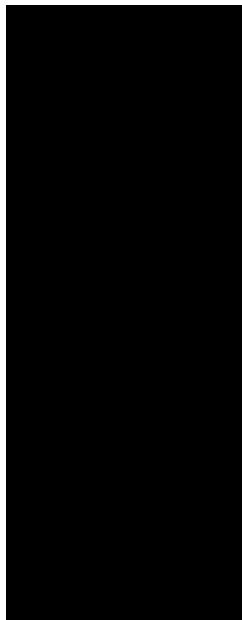
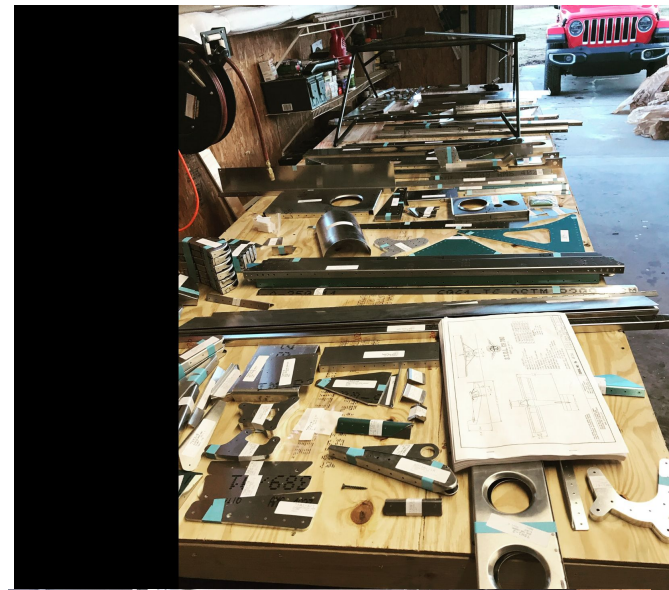
His kit project is progressing nicely. He purchased his kit on November 18th and began working on December 1st.

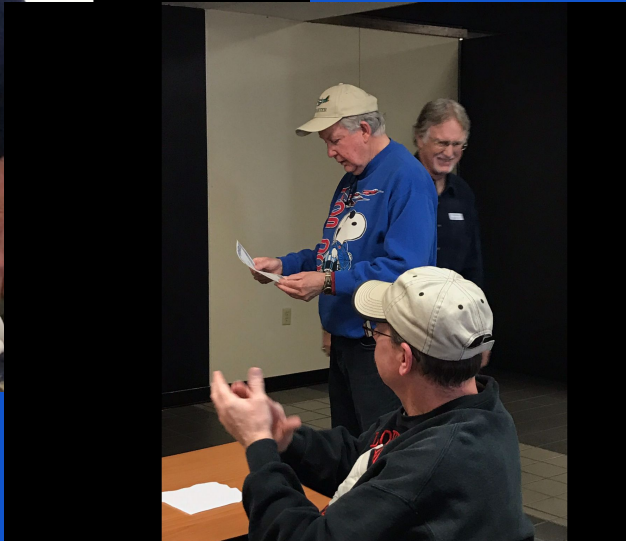

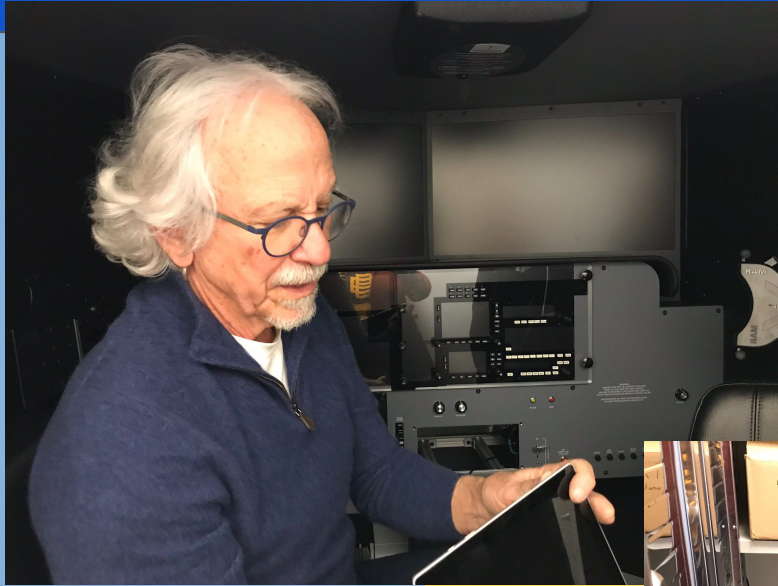
