On the security gate keypad, punch in "#1228" (five keystrokes - Pound One Two Two Eight). You will hear a beep and a few seconds later the gate will open. Drive west as far as you can, taking you to the west-most row of hangers. Ted's P60 hanger faces east. Park on grass anywhere in the vicinity, but please make sure your car does not overhang any hard surface for wing clearance. There is a lot of additional space south of Ted's hanger for parking. If you arrive after 6:45-7:00, you may have to park in the main parking lot by Blue Skies Pilot Shop and walk over.) Remember, last call for burgers is 6:50!
