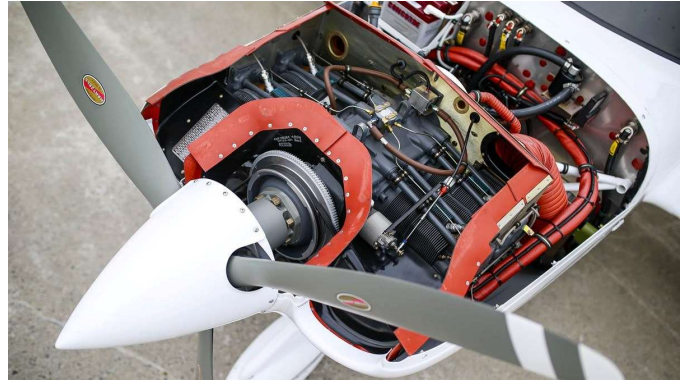

New AD for Lycoming Engines due to Engine Failures



The FAA published a new AD related to Lycoming Engine models with affected parts that were shipped and installed between 2009 and 2017. These engines were installed in Cirrus, Cessna, Piper, Robinson, Extra, Techam, Mooney and Beechcraft. The AD is set to go into effect December 5, 2004
