

Payson Aerofair Brief

- ∞ Town Parks & Rec supportive, Town management not so much
 - Parks willing to help prep parking areas, actually working now
 - Requested Airport Coordinator to implement a meeting with Parks & Rec management but nothing yet, anticipate no more formal meetings before event
- ∞ Aerofair Committee has purchased liability insurance to protect PPA and volunteers, liability for event, and has provided Boy Scout coverage.
- ∞ Local donors have been working with Army Aviation Heritage Foundation for selling public rides in a Huey helicopter.
 - Support still unresolved
- ∞ Coordinating with Commemorative Air Force (C.A.F.)
 - C-45 best possibility for providing rides to public
- ∞ Payson High School DECA Club engaged
 - Taking over Social Media for event
 - Working closely with Aerofair staff
- ∞ KMOG contract in place
 - Spot advertising, 1hour Forum, and live from event broadcasting
 - Coordinating with our MC
- ∞ Aerofair parking remains an issue if attendance anticipated is realized
 - Church for the Nations agreed to allow use of their parking lot event day
 - Possible use of Alpha ramp for parking
 - TOP recognizes problem and seems to be helping
- ∞ Supporters have developed a plan for “Best of Show” contest
 - Public to vote during event and trophies will be awarded prior to closure of event
- ∞ Display requests coming in
 - Border Patrol will have both a booth and an A Star display
 - AZANG furnishing a ch-60 for display
 - Yuma USMC has us on calendar but not assigned display vehicle yet
- ∞ More participation by aviation community is needed for a successful event
 - Volunteer task signup developed for signups
 - Email went out to all aviation orgs requesting volunteers
