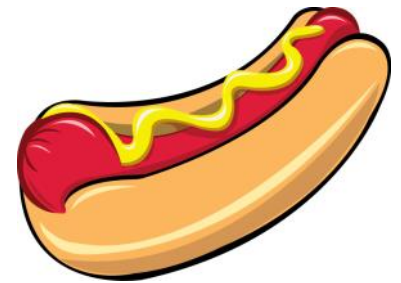

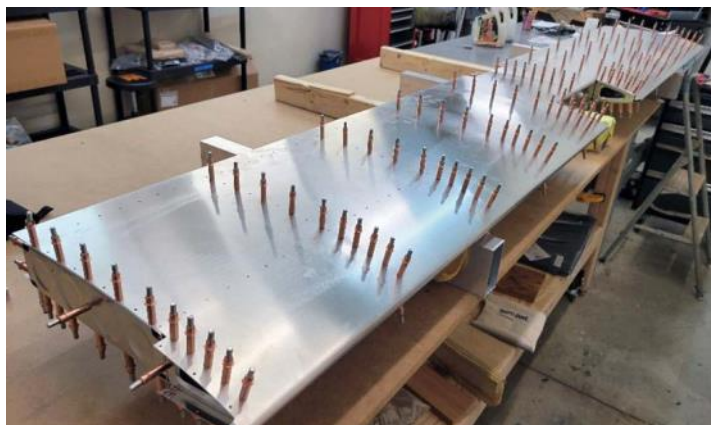

Rans S-21 - Build Update

Since I received my RANS S-21 kit on 3 April, I've been busy deburring, installing clecos and pulling rivets. All the tail feathers are complete- the rudder, vertical stab, horizontal stab, elevator and trim tab. I've been working on the left wing for about 2 weeks and it is ready to cleco on the skin for initial fit and match drilling. The majority of the rivet holes in the kit are pre-punched or drilled at the factory with only critical match drilling and fitting to do on spars and attach points like the wing mounts. I still have a lot of work to do on the left wing—running wires for nav/strobe, landing lights, pitot heat, installing the pitot tube and OAT probe, installing the fuel tank—before it's ready for final riveting of the top and bottom skins. So far, I've been very impressed with the fit and finish of all the kit components. Rans does a great job in this regard.

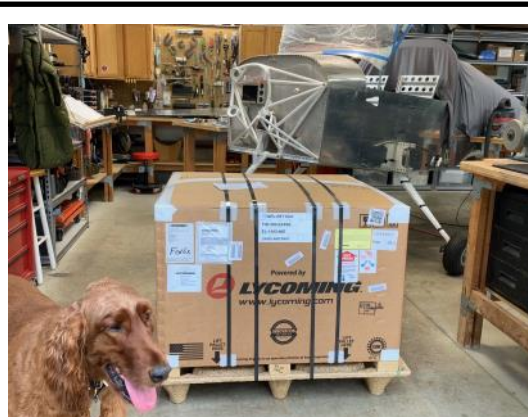


Joe Begany's Memorial at Oshkosh

Fluids and Combustion- Propulsion mixtures and fuel efficiency

The Orion Project- Developing space craft for long range space travel

Radioisotopes- Developing a power system by taking heat and turning it into electricity.
