

Alert- Bald Eagle Notice, 7G8

It has been confirmed that there is a pair of Eagles northeast of the field, in the RED square. There are reports recently of people seeing them flying around and landing in the area shown in ORANGE. I think it's important to get the word out to the flying community to:

- 1. Aircraft departing in RNY 11 need to stay on runway centerline until 2,000' before turning Northbound
- 2. Avoid overflying these Orange & Red areas at all times when coming in for landing. This pertains to helicopters, [UH in particular], who enter a RH base in this area. Eagles are not going to be confined to these arbitrary squares on a map and should be given a wide birth around their nest in RED. Check for NOTAM.


First US Customer...

He traveled to Kent, Illinois (north west corner of the state) to visit with the U.S. dealer, and the only U.S. builder of this airplane, to study his project and ask a million questions. He previously saw this same airplane at the Midwest LSA Expo last September. The airplane is produced mostly as completed airplanes in France for the European market where there are many of them flying, and have been for 15 years. There are also 2 planes flying and 2 more nearly complete in Ontario, Canada where another dealer and partner is operating. Steve expects to

get his kit in July and will be building it in his home shop in Granger Twp.

"Attention" Young Eagles Day June 11, 2022! By Gary Baker

The Annual EAA Chapter 846 Young Eagles Day will be held Saturday, June 11, 2022, from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. This event will be held at Wayne County Airport (KBJJ) this year. The folks at Wayne County have always been very receptive to us when we have held events there. We will operate out of the main hangar.

There will be some set-up Friday afternoon/evening. More details on that to come. Final set-up will be Saturday morning beginning at 7 a.m. Pilots will be asked to arrive by 8:15, if possible. A pilot briefing will be held at 8:30 a.m.

The event will be advertised in various local online calendars. Preregistration will be available and recommended by going to https://tiny.one/846YE. Preregistration will be allowed on May 1.

A few iPads will be requested for the registration folks to use. EAA has developed a signature app to be used on the iPad which allows the parents and pilots to digitally sign the paperwork. This should cut down on complications caused by lost paperwork.

All chapter pilots who would like to fly kids for the Young Eagles program are asked to let Gary know as soon as possible. An email will be sent to chapter members inviting them to register as YE pilots. Of course, pilots are required to have completed the EAA Youth Protection

Program. This involves an on-line course, taking about fifteen minutes, and agreeing to a background check. More information can be found at https://tiny.one/EAAYPP. A pilot sign-up sheet will also be passed around during the April Gathering.

Our chapter has flown 3,239 kids since we began in 1994. This year, 2022, is being recognized as the thirtieth year of the Young Eagles program. Special recognition will be given to pilots who fly thirty kids this year and next. Volunteer Young Eagles pilots who fly 30 youths between August 1, 2022, and July 31, 2023, will be awarded a commemorative polo shirt. Special pins will also be available for volunteers.


THE GREAT "RANS" RACE

STILL LEADING– Randy's S-21 Build:



Work continues on my S-21 project. I installed all the fittings in the 6.9 gal. header tank and installed it on the floor below the forward baggage area. Then I installed the HP fuel boost pump, the fuel selector valve and the associated SS fuel lines. In addition, I permanently mounted the Garmin Aileron Autopilot servo. Finally. I

fabricated and installed the various antenna doubler plates and riveted them in place on the bottom and top skins around the cockpit area. The big news is that my prewired instrument panel and Garmin avionics arrived from SteinAir. The panel turned out great and the wiring is a work of art.
