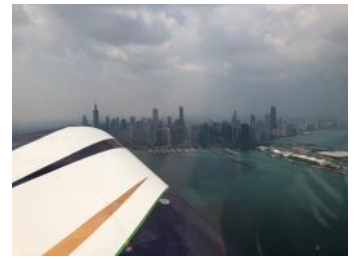

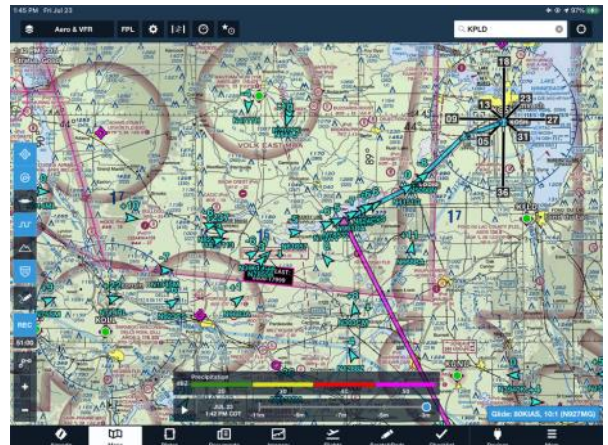
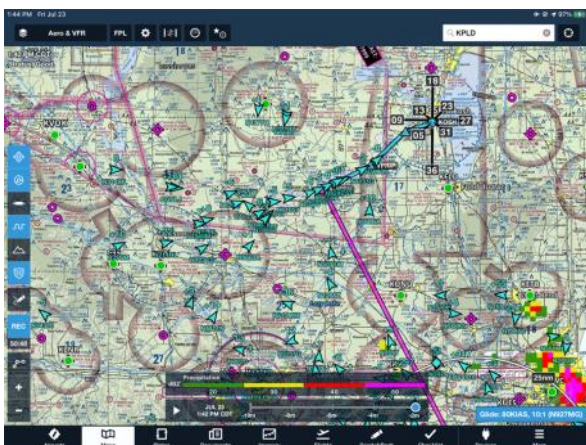
Flying into Oshkosh

Rick Katai once again joined me for the flight into Oshkosh Friday, July 23, using the new Notam procedures. We flew north of Toledo because of some rain showers and then picked up an IFR clearance because of some lowering ceilings. After refueling at Michigan City, IN, we flew the Chicago Flyway again as in past years and got some hazy photos of downtown Chicago. As we got within seventy-five miles of Oshkosh, we were monitoring 123.45 and hearing other pilots relay the new transition entry point for the VFR arrival. We were initially told that the Green Lake transition was in play, so I modified my route on ForeFlight. As we got closer, we were able to hear Fisk Approach and heard them move everyone out to the Puckaway Lake transition, so another modification to the flight route was needed.



Within ten miles of Puckaway Lake, we began following a Cessna 182 but then he turned toward Green Lake. I didn't think that was correct, so we continued to Puckaway Lake and fell in line behind an RV-8. We found that this transition did a nice job of spreading aircraft out and allowing everyone to get acclimated to following someone. There were fewer aircraft that attempted to cut in front of others and Fisk Approach was quick to call those folks out by N number and tell them to go back and restart the procedure. We followed the RV-8 all the way to Fisk and were offered either runway, so I chose 36. OSH Tower cleared us to land on the yellow dot and so I cruised over the top of the dot at three feet and touched down some fifty to hundred feet past it. Missed it again! We taxied off and followed the flagmen to row 353 in the Homebuilt Aircraft Parking and this was home for the week for my RV-6.

-Chapter Pancake Breakfast/Fly-in Update: Greg Cantrell

The date for the chapter pancake breakfast and fly-in is September 18, 2021. A planning meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, July 13th at 7 pm, in the chapter hangar. All members are invited.

-Young Eagles Update: Gary Baker

Gary reported that Saturday July 17, 2021, will be the day the chapter provides Young Eagle flights at Wadsworth Airport. He has sent out an 'on-line' signup sheet for the event. We have 6 pilots signed up to fly. Arrival time for all volunteers is 7:30 am. Plan to work until Noon.

-Monthly Program: Flying to AirVenture: Gary Baker & Randy Brooks

Gary Baker presented information about flying into and out of AirVenture for both VFR and IFR. Emphasizing the importance of using the NOTAM booklet (now available) and printouts for thoroughly planning the flight before leaving. This is vitally important due to the many new procedures in place for 2021. Gary's comments were seasoned by his personal experience of flying into Oshkosh AirVenture over the past 30 years.

Randy Brooks presented on the 'Ground Operations' at AirVenture. Randy spoke about the many things you should be prepared for regarding receiving instructions from the ground marshaller crews (all wearing orange/yellow vest) once you have landed. He stressed to never make a turn without being directed by the ground crew. This will be Randy's 8th year working with ground operations at AirVenture.

Jeremy Cowgar- Zenith 750- Fuel flow testing was completed with first engine start.
