Minutes from EA Chapter 850 Membership Meeting July 17, 2021

No commitment has been made to retain a portion of 600 or build a new building. Greg suggested that chapter members attend the upcoming County Board meeting July 20 in Commission Chambers to lobby for a positive resolution. Discussion followed.

After discussion a motion was made and passed to hold a Young Eagle Rally on Saturday, August 21 instead of our August meeting with a rain date of Sunday, August 22. Details to follow. Expect the flying sign-up times to be divided into 2 time slots as used at our previous rally.
