• HEADSET DONATED TO CHAPTER 878 YOUNG EAGLES PROGRAM REPAIRED BY DAVID CLARK by Kyle Weatherly

Earlier this year the chapter put out a request for donations of headsets and portable intercom systems that our volunteer pilots could use if their plane was not equipped with an intercom, or if they did not have enough headsets.

We had a great response and now have several headsets available for use.

However, one donated headset (a David Clark H10-60) did not work. I contacted the David Clark Company about getting it repaired and they responded in an extraordinary manner. Not only did they replace the microphone, comm cord, headpad and seals at no charge, they even returned the repaired unit "freight paid!"

It's good to know that companies such as David Clark support the Young Eagles program and EAA chapters in such an outstanding manner.

We could still use more headsets, intercoms or other aviation equipment that you might be willing to donate. It would also be great to have extra portable radios to be used by the Young Eagles or their parents or guardians. Please contact me if you have something to contribute. Remember that EAA Chapter 878 is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization and donated items would be a tax deductible contribution.

• CHAPTER POSITIONS STILL OPEN by Greg Thomes

As previously noted in the newsletter, the possibility of adding two new volunteer position is open: *Culinary Officer* and *Beverage Coordinator*. During the summer months we've enjoyed a light meal before our chapter meetings. This meal helps to entice members to attend and it's a good social time for members. Persons interested in volunteering for these two positions (or one combined position) is asked to step forward. It's an easy way to be more involved in the chapter and reduces the workload of the president!

Culinary Officer: Assist the Chapter President in organizing and offering a light meal at certain chapter meetings held from April to November. Any food purchased will be reimbursed by the chapter. Members at large will be encouraged to provide a "dish to share" to make the meal task easier.
