
## The Maple Lake Flyer


summer I learned to fly not only taught me about weight & balance and flight planning, but about who I was as a person and how strong I really was. Flying changed my life.

Sadly, as many pilots can also attest to, I had to stop flying due to financial reasons. I took 20 years out of the controls. I traveled for work and always fought down the temptation to turn left instead of right when I got in a plane.

Thankfully, five years ago I met a NetJet pilot in a friend's kitchen in Sioux Falls and we talked "pilot" for three hours. When I think of that, I can still feel

the butterflies of excitement in my stomach to this day. I allowed myself to remember how much I loved the stick and rudder, planning a flight, executing a landing and simply being in the air.


