- **MINUTES OF MEETING, Feb. 9, 2013**

Meeting called to order by President Tom Rammel with 21 members and guests. Wayne Flury then introduced our program presenter, James Aarestad, who conducted a flight review ground school. James focused his presentation on a review of airspace classifications and operations in each. While each person at the class had access to a Twin Cities Sectional Map, it was noted that it is permissible to use an I-Pad in place of charts for your flying activities (though you must verify that the device does not cause any interferences with aircraft instruments). At the end of the program, he provided a certificate of completion to anyone who wanted it. But he noted that if you used this class as a part of your biennial flight review, the "clock starting ticking" with the date of the class! That is, the 24 calendar month timeframe begins now and not whenever you accomplish the flying portion of the flight review.



After the class, a brief meeting was conducted for any items of essential business...there were none. It was noted that the Secretary's Report (minutes of last meetings) is always in the newsletter, as is the Treasurer's Report, and thus there was no formal presentation.

The April meeting will be a pancake breakfast for chapter members, family and friends, to be held in Tim Bond's hangar at the Maple Lake Airport. Glen Morrow noted he has usually picked up supplies for the breakfast, but he will be out of town at SUN 'n FUN this year, so Marv Sikkila volunteered to do this.


