Fly-outs: Saturday, September 17, 2022, is the OPA end of "Explore Oregon" air rally. There will be a precision drop at 10:00 AM and a BBQ to follow in the OPA clubhouse. Prizes will be awarded.

Sunday, September 25, 2022 is the Jordan Valley Dinner. It will be at the Scio, OR airport (Gillette Field OR51). There will be a car show and airplanes flying in. This is a fly-out for the Chapter. Meet there at 10:00 AM to get tickets for the meal. Pete will email information on the dinner to members.

Milestones: Devin Rounsville passed his check ride and earned his Private Pilot certificate. He is one of this year's Ray scholars. Congratulations, Devin!

Raffle: Phil Groelz won the 50/50 raffle.

Tech Tip: Phil G. talked about aerodynamic lift. One-third of the lift is from the bottom of the wing and two-thirds is from the top and

trailing edge of the wing. During a stall, the plane loses one-third of its lift.

Events: WAAAM Fly-out/Drive-out was this past weekend, September 9-11, 2022. Several 902 members drove to the event due to the high winds in the Willamette Valley and the Gorge. The Ford Tri-Motor was flown and did several take-offs and landings before returning to the airport. Weather was beautiful at Hood River Airport with a clear sky and light winds.

Board Meeting September 21th

President Pete Gauthier called the Board Meeting to order around 7:08 PM. Nine members were present. The meeting was held at the OPA Clubhouse with pizza and salad.

Minutes: The minutes from the September 14, 2022 meeting were provided and reviewed. Len Fierling made a motion to approve the minutes. Bob Armstrong seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion carried. Minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Steve Miller emailed the treasurer's report showing a total of \$11,233.94. Among the four of them, the Ray Scholars have about \$6,373 in funds available. The total that belongs in the account should be \$8233.94.

Larry Stevens moved to accept the Treasurer's report. Len F seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion carried.

Raffle: Len F. will continue to handle the 50/50 raffle.

The silent auction for the Whelen light will be in October or November. A reserve will be set for the light. Ray Peabody will provide model number to be placed in the October newsletter.

Henry Pflegl will provide a presentation on the 2022 Reno Air Race for the November meeting.
