- 2. DO A THOROUGH PREFLIGHT INSPECTION WITH CHECKLIST
- 3. DO A POST FLIGHT INSPECTION JUST TO BE SURE SHES OK
- 4. KEEP UP YOUR PROFICIENCY, FLY AS OFTEN AS YOU CAN
- 5. PRACTICE EMERGENCY PROCEDURES, THE WHAT IF RULE.
- 6. BRIEF YOUR PASSENGERS, THEY NEED TO KNOW, JUST IN CASE.
- 7. HAVE A BACKUP NAV PLAN. A MAP OR A PHONE APP.
- 8. PAY ATTENTION AND FLY THE AIRPLANE. ITS EASY TO BE LAZY.
- 9. ALWAYS COMMUNICATE YOUR INTENTIONS TO OTHER TRAFFIC AT UNCONTROLLED FIELDS.
- 10. ABOVE ALL, STAY ALERT AND ALWAYS BE LOOKING OUT FOR OTHER AIRCRAFT.
