## 2017 Nationals



Sandy and I had attended the US Nationals in Oshkosh, where I had a great challenge competing in Unlimited against mostly youthful pilots, flying those high powered monoplanes. Sandy (judge for ADV & assistant judge for other categories) and I (assistant to chief judge for SPM) sat many 4-5 hours sessions at the judges line during a variety of weather conditions. It was lots of fun being there, a totally new experience, at least for me, and an opportunity to see many former competitors and friends from years past. We had great weather, although, some days were rather windy, blowing one right out of the box.

There were 92 competitors, of which 17 competed in the glider category.

The upper categories have become a competition between monoplanes:

Advanced Category - out of 25 competitors, 20 competed in monoplanes, there were 5 Pitts

Unlimited Category - out of 11 competitors, 9 competed in monoplanes, there were 2 Pitts (S2S and S1E)

Congratulations to Larry Ernewein, who placed FIRST in the Sportsman category with his Bucker Jungmann.
